**ORDINANCE NO. 16-05**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF  
CERTAIN ITEMS OF PERSONAL PROPERTY**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Rochester, Sangamon County, State of Illinois, is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Rochester (hereinafter, the “Village”), is an Illinois municipal corporation; and,

**WHEREAS**, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, grants municipalities, with a population less than 500,000, the authority to sell and dispose of personal property it determines, by a simple majority of the corporate authorities, to be no longer useful and necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Rochester has an older piece of exercise equipment, being a “leg press” in storage; and

**WHEREAS**, the Macomb Police Department has a good working relationship with the Village of Rochester and would like to acquire said older, stored “leg press” piece of exercise equipment, further documented in Exhibit A; and

**WHEREAS**, said “leg press” is not currently being used by the Village of Rochester Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board desires to declare as surplus and transfer ownership of said item as set forth on Exhibit A to the Macomb Police Department

**WHEREAS**, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Rochester find that property items set forth in this Resolution are no longer useful or necessary and ownership shall be transferred as set forth herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Rochester, County of Sangamon, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.     Recitals.** The above recitals are incorporated herein by this reference as if specifically stated in full.

**Section 2.     Disposition of Property.** The property described on Exhibit A is hereby declared to be surplus property by the Village. In consideration of \$250.00 from the Macomb Police Department, the Village Board hereby does transfer ownership of the personal property described in Exhibit A to Macomb Police Department. The Village President is herein authorized to execute any and all documentation necessary to effectuate the transfer in ownership of the property described as Exhibit A.

**Section 3.     Repeal & Savings Clause.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, actions, or causes of action which shall have accrued to the Village of Rochester prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
