BOARD AND COMMISSION REPORTS

Plan & Zoning Commission – Chairman Maras presented the following:

Mr. Steve Luparell provided S1.0 Structural drawing for Rocket Plaza (447 State Street). No motion to approve or deny at this time. The structural drawing needs more details. Mr. Luparell will work with Joe Petty to provide and will resubmit the Structural drawing. Mr. Luparell's current goal is to work on the building façade and then the roof. A special Planning and Zoning Commission meeting to review the revised Structural drawing may be scheduled if necessary.

The Floor Plan previously submitted earlier to the Commission has been reviewed.

A permit for only the front façade can be obtained following Commission/Board approvals. Permits for other changes – back, inside etc. will need to be submitted once vendor agreements obtained. Plumbing and HVAC drawings will need to be submitted.

OLD BUSINESS

Clerk read announcement for a public hearing to be held on Tuesday, July 26, 2016 at 6pm in the Village Hall for the proposed Rochester TIF District I.

TRUSTEE REPORTS

SEWER – Trustee Zobrist – Southeast Pump Station work is moving along. Rochester State Bank (RSB) proposal received to fund Southeast Pump Station work with a 2.49% interest rate with no pre-payment penalty. Public Works committee supports approval of RSB loan proposal and Village Manager prepared necessary paperwork for a vote. Transfer switch for the generator at the Primary Pump Station has been working satisfactorily and will delay the installation of a replacement for now. Village engineer has completed a draft for the required MS4 report.

STREETS – Trustee Eandi – Nothing new to report.

WATER – Trustee Hendrickson – Trying to coordinate work on Walberta Drive with gas line work being done. Water flushing will continue in the fall. Annual Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) posted - water is tested repeatedly to ensure safety. Village water supply very safe. Report available in Village Office and online. In terms of purchasing water, the Village is purchasing 7 million gallons per month and only billing for about 6 million gallons. Water meters may need to be checked to determine where the loss is occurring.

POLICE – Trustee Liken -- Monthly police report distributed to members.

PUBLIC HEALTH & SAFETY – Trustee Munroe – First Movie in the Park was a success. July 16th is the next movie and also the rain date for fireworks if needed. At this time fireworks are scheduled for July 3rd. Still looking for sponsorships for Sparks in the Park at any monetary level. New to Sparks this year is a petting zoo. Ticket pre-sale will begin June 24th at Beginning Steps and Rochester Library. Activity at the park is heavy with baseball due to such a wet spring.

VILLAGER MANAGER'S REPORT

Village Manager discussed several items on the agenda this evening.

- Prevailing Wage Ordinance – IL Department of Labor has not posted the June 2016 Prevailing Wage Report for Sangamon County. Hoping to get it posted in July.
- The amendment to the Professional Services Agreement is increasing the number of parcels allowed in the establishment and annual administration of Rochester TIF District I from 150 parcels to 350 parcels before any additional cost per parcel.
- Ordinance to authorize the establishment of a TIF “Interested Parties Registry” and adopting registration rules for the registries for the Rochester TIF District I.
- Village is again applying for a grant for the “Cardinal Hill Sidewalk Project”. We have been receiving letters of support from the school, businesses, and government officials for this project.

There are several ordinances and resolutions that are already being worked on for the July 11, 2016, Board meeting. The Employee Personnel Policy will be ready and the fence ordinance will be discussed in committee.

Village Manager will be attending an information workshop with the IL Department of Revenue on June 15th.
