APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE VILLAGE OF ROCHESTER ORDINANCE NO 25-10

An ordinance appropriating for all corporate purposes for the Village of Rochester, Sangamon County, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2025, and ending April 30, 2026

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustee of the Village of Rochester, Sangamon County, Illinois:

SECTION 1: That the amount hereinafter set forth, or so much thereof as may be authorized by law, and as may be needed or deemed necessary to defray all expenses and liabilities of the municipality be the same are hereby appropriated for the corporate purposes of the Village of Rochester, Sangamon County, Illinois, as hereinafter specified for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2025, and ending April 30, 2026

SECTION 2: That the appropriation herein made for any purpose shall be regarded as the maximum amounts to be expended under the respective appropriation accounts and shall not be construed as a commitment, agreement, obligation or liability of the Village of Rochester, and such appropriation being subject to further approval as to the expenditure thereof by the Village Board

SECTION 3: That the amount appropriated for each object and purpose shall be as follows:
